Statements from the winners

Marathon: "I was a bit worried at the start, I didn't want to burn through the first half. After that I wanted to run my own pace. After that I wanted to run my own pace. About halfway down the course, I run away from my rivals. Roman Fosti was catching up with me, but I kept my lead. It turned out that no one is guaranteed victory in advance, even if he has an excellent personal record. Many champions have not finished the marathon, it is the most difficult running race. Mentally, it was a challenging marathon for me today, it's hard to run against someone who has better times," said a satisfied Taras Ivaniuta at the finish line.

Marathon: "I'm satisfied with the time of 2:59:29," smiled **Ines Jozič**, endurance runner, 100 km specialist and 12-hour runner from Slavonského Brod, Croatia. "My goal today was clear: just run. I focus on ultramarathons more than marathons, I have five 100 km runs to my credit, and I hold the Croatian record in the twelve-hour race. The weather was excellent today, it suited me."

Half marathon: "I didn't expect a personal record," admitted 31-year-old" Matúš Hujsa. "From the eighth km I ran alone, I did not expect that it would be possible to improve like this on such a route. I didn't have a crisis really, but in the sections against the wind I had to make a lot of effort to maintain the pace. Elsewhere, the wind at my back helped me. The last km with the run-up to the Starý most and the descent to the finish line really hurt."

Half marathon: Zuzana Polohová: "Today I have set myself in such a way that it will either work out or not. It worked and I am very happy. I wanted to improve my personal best a little more. I ran with Lucka Pelikánová and in the end I had more strength than she had. It's definitely one of the biggest wins in my career."

Minimarathon: "Despite the windy conditions, I had a great run. The first and last kilometres were fast and the feeling was not bad at all. Even at the end, I had enough strength, which makes me happy. And also from the resulting time," stated Žofia Naňová, who was overtaken by only the three best men.
